

Trondheim

Trondheim is by population Norway's third largest city, with approximately 180 000 inhabitants. It was the capital of Norway between 1030 and 1217 and is today the administrative and industrial hub of the central section of Norway. The city lies by the Trondheim fjord around the estuary of the river Nidelva.

Among the many interesting sights in Trondheim we find the Nidaros Cathedral, the Kristiansten Fortress, and the Munkholmen Island. Trondheim is also the home of NTNU, the second largest university in Norway.

The distance from Oslo to Trondheim is approximately 310 miles. From the city centre to the airport the distance is about 20 miles.
